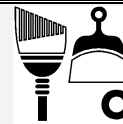

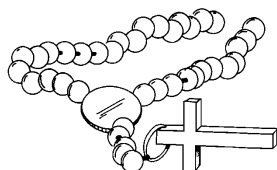

SHROUD OF TURIN and HOLY LAND PILGRIMAGE

Join Fr. Jeff Statz of St. Joseph Catholic Church in Woodsville, NH on a special tour to view the Holy Shroud of Turin combined with a visit to the Holy Land. Let us rejoice in the Resurrection as we walk in the footsteps of Jesus throughout the Holy Land.
